Love is the “crown” of all attributes. Notice the following thoughts

(1) Love is the last of the Christian graces F, V, K, T, P, G, BK, C/L- II Peter 1:7

(2) Love is the greatest commandment - Matt 22:34-40

Matt 22:36-40 Master, which [is] the great commandment in the law? (37) Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. (38) This is the first and great commandment. (39) And the second [is] like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. (40) On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

(3) Love will always be needed I Cor 13:3 Faith, hope, charity but the greatest is charity

(4) Can't Buy Love - Song of Sol 8:7

Song of Sol 8:7 Many waters cannot quench love, neither can the floods drown it: if [a] man would give all the substance of his house for love, it would utterly be contemned. [Contemned – we would say contempt (syn scorn; disdain; despise)]

(5) Perfect Col 3:14

Col 3:14 And above all these things [put on] charity, which is the bond of perfectness.

(6) We are sons because of Love I John 3:1

I John 3:1 Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.
